Students transferring their SEVIS record from another U.S. institution to UMass Lowell will receive an I-20/DS-2019 with the same SEVIS number as their previous school and are not required to pay a new SEVIS fee.

We do not issue Form I-20 or DS-2019 to students with a terminated SEVIS status. We do not support in-country reinstatement OR issue reinstatement visa documents to new incoming students. If you are currently out of status, we are happy to any questions you may have and/or refer you to an immigration attorney for assistance.
